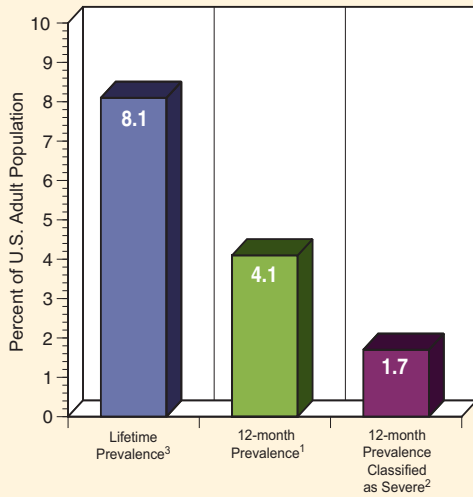


# Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)

## Prevalence

- **12-month Prevalence:** 4.1% of U.S. adult population<sup>1</sup>
- **Severe:** 41.3% of these cases (e.g., 1.7% of U.S. adult population) are classified as “severe”<sup>2</sup>
