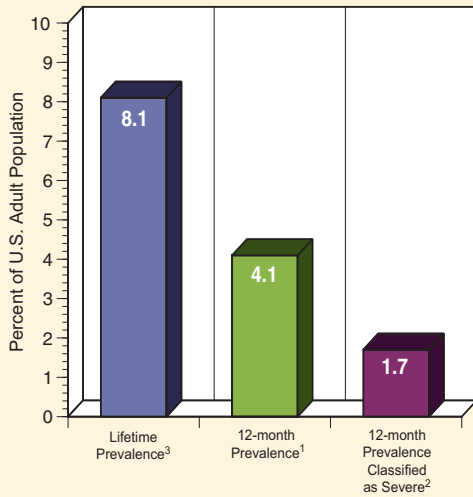


Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)

Prevalence

- **12-month Prevalence:** 4.1% of U.S. adult population¹
- **Severe:** 41.3% of these cases (e.g., 1.7% of U.S. adult population) are classified as “severe”²
