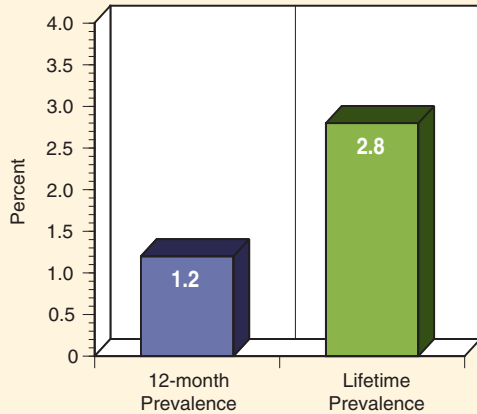


# Binge Eating Disorder

## Prevalence

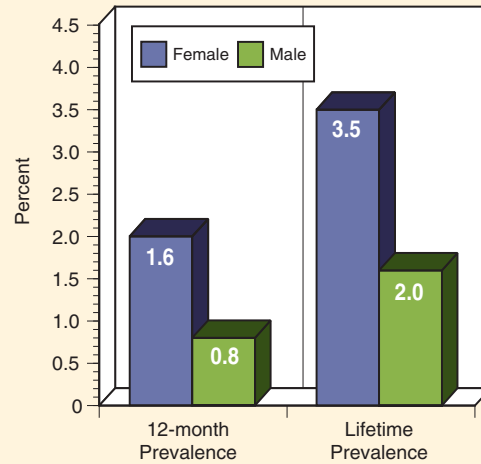
- **12-month Prevalence:** 1.2% of U.S. adult population
- **Severe:** Not Reported
- **Lifetime Prevalence:** 2.8% of U.S. adult population



**Average Age-of-Onset:** 25 years old

### Sex:



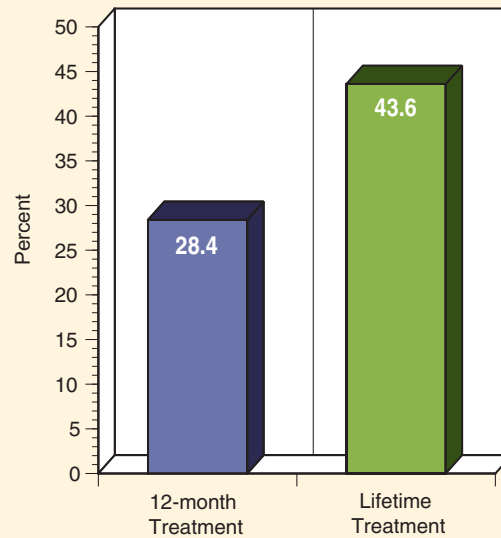
### Race: Not Reported

### Age:

- People ages 18–29, 30–44, and 45–59 were all significantly more likely than 60+ year olds to suffer from binge eating disorder

## Treatment/Services Use

- **12-month Treatment for Binge Eating Disorder:** 28.4% of those with disorder are receiving treatment
- **Lifetime Treatment for Binge Eating Disorder:** 43.6% of those with disorder are receiving treatment
